



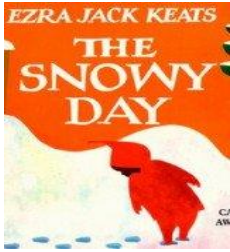

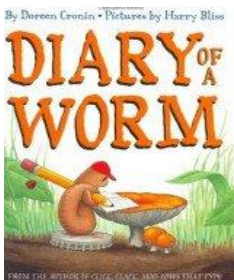
BOOK CORNER

GRADE 1



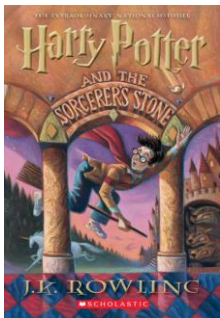
In The Snowy Day, Peter wakes up to find that snow has fallen — and he can't wait to go outside and play.
