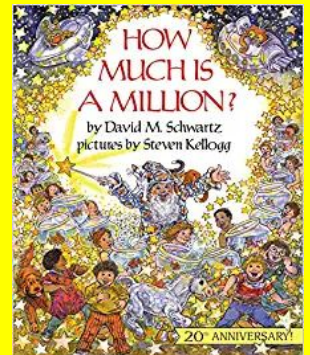


MATH Reading Log Recommendation
