Tips for Parents of Struggling Readers

1. Selecting a book-Is this book at my child's reading level? Do they like the genre?
2. Encourage your child to read aloud-Listening to reading is extremely important, and the discussion about interesting words and how the story is unfolding is valuable in comprehension.
3. Listen to Audio books-Listening to good reading helps children learn what their own reading should sound like.
